






IIMS MBA Sanction Intake Yearwise


Number of Students admission in MBA Year Wise

Main body of report

The highlights of the budget discussed by students are as follows:

Infrastructure development

- ➤ 100 PM Gati Shakti cargo terminals will be developed during the next 3 years.
- ➤ 400 new Vande Bharat trains will be launched in next 3 years.
- > Expressway to be.
- Mission jal jeevan to provide tab water to households in coming years.
- > Implementation of Ken Betwa Link Project benefitting 9.1 lakh hectare farmland.

- > 80 lakh homes to build under PM Awas Yojana.
- ➤ To enhance transparency a paperless end to end online e-bill system for use by all central ministries.

Telecommunication & travel

- > 5G spectrum auction to be conducted in 2022.
- E-passport will be launched for overseas travel.
- Affordable broadband to introduce in rural areas and 5% funding is provided by government under this scheme.

Finance and tax

- ➤ No change in slab rate.
- > Tax relief to person with disability.
- ➤ Co-operative society's tax rate to reduce to 15% and surcharge reduced to 7%.
- > RBI to announce its digital currency.
- ➤ Virtual digital currency to be taxed at 30%.
- Digital banking by post offices 100% of post offices to come on the core banking system.
- From 2 years of AY. You can update your ITR by paying additional tax of 25-50%.

Education and health

- > E-Vaidya scheme to be launched.
- ➤ One class one TV channel program to be expanded to 200 TV channels.
- A digital university will be set up by the government for providing online education in multiple languages.
- > 23 mental health center's will be setup
- National digital health ecosystem will significantly enhance ease of living for citizens and create a healthier India.

Women and children

- ➤ Mission Shakti, mission Vatsale, sakshem anganwadi 2.0 this schemes are announced for women welfare.
- ➤ 2 lakh anganwadi to upgraded under the sakshem anganwadi scheme.

Agriculture and startups

- Agricultural startups to be funded.
- ➤ Domestic production of edible oil to be given preference.
- ➤ Government would promote chemical free natural farming throughout the country to boost sustainable agricultural productivity and income of the farmers.
- ➤ Kisan drones will be used for crop assessment of land records.
- ➤ Ken-Betwa river linking project is announced.
- > Tax incentives for startups increased from three years to four years of incorporation.




he permission of device users. He also spoke about key loggers programs which may steal the login Id and password of the user's device.



Yashaswi Education Society's International Institute of Management Science organized a webinar on Human Rights on 23rd Feb 2022 at 11.00 am. All students of MBA, MCA, faculty members and staff were present for the webinar.

human being has been given certain rights by constitution, everyone need to know their fundamental rights and responsibilities and implications of these rights and responsibilities in his life for survival and growth.

He said Human rights are rights inherent to all human beings, regardless of race, sex, nationality, ethnicity, language, religion, or any other status. Human rights include the right to life and liberty, freedom from slavery and torture, freedom of opinion and expression, the right to work and education, and many more. Everyone is entitled to these rights, without discrimination.

He discussed the classification of rights such as legal right, labors rights, farmer's rights, and constitutional rights. All they are localized rights as they differ from country to country and class to class.

He said human rights is a global concept. The human rights are given in our constitution. These rights are the basic rights and freedoms that belong to every person in the world. They can never be taken away.

The basic rights are like liberty, dignity, justice, equality, respect and independence.

He elaborated the sources of human rights. They are Universal declaration of human rights of 1948 after the Second World War, International treaties and covalence, International customs, judicial decisions and official documents.

He elaborated on the evolution of human rights and discussed the types of human rights are civil and political rights, economic and social rights, and collective rights.

He also quoted Verginia declaration 11776. This declaration specifies number of fundamental rights. It states that all men are by nature are equally free, independent and have certain inherent rights.

He interacted with the students to solve their queries and shared his experience and valuable knowledge.

He said human rights need be a part of everyone's education. As we have rights, as well we have duties that we should not disturb others' lives, there should not be any abuse or injustice. If these rights are violated, person can approach the human rights commission at central level as well as state level.
