Satisfaction Survey Analysis for Year 2022-23**

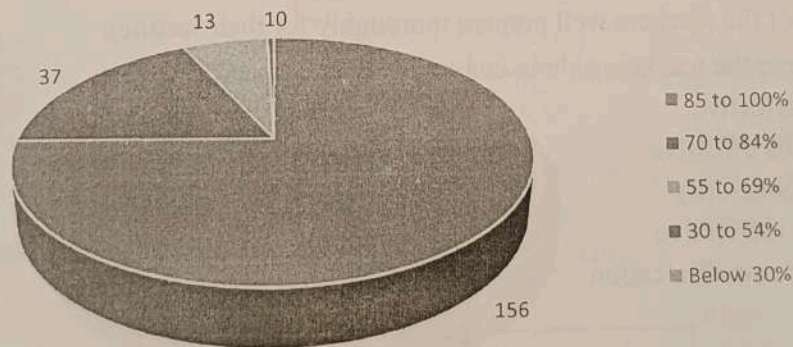

Interpretation: Every professor is preferring to cover the entire syllabus.

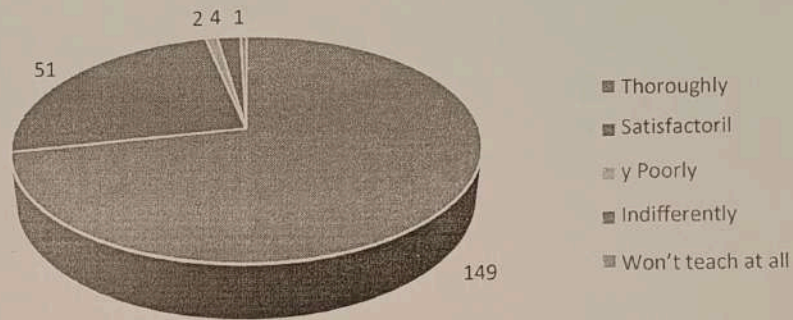

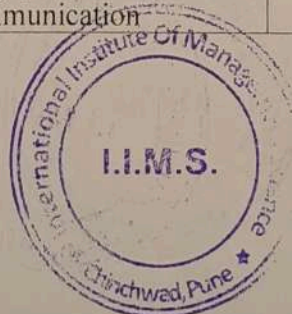


Interpretation: Most of the teachers well prepare thoroughly for their lectures

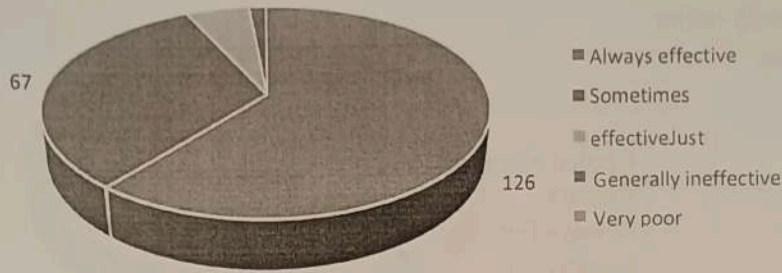

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How well were the teachers able to communicate?



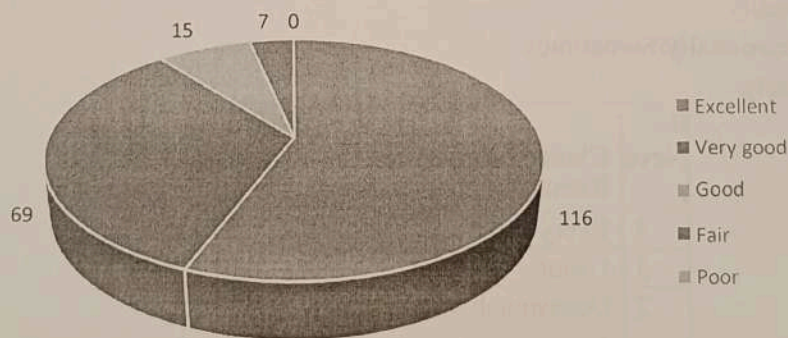

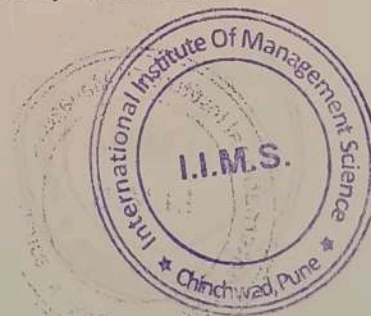

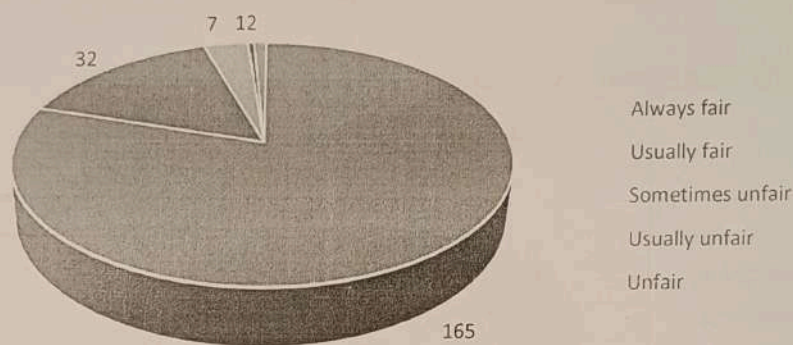



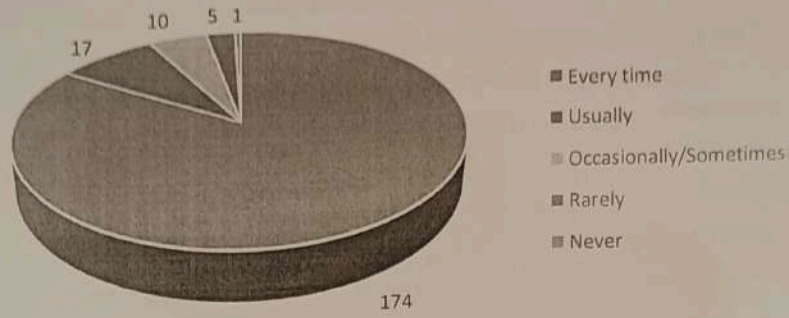

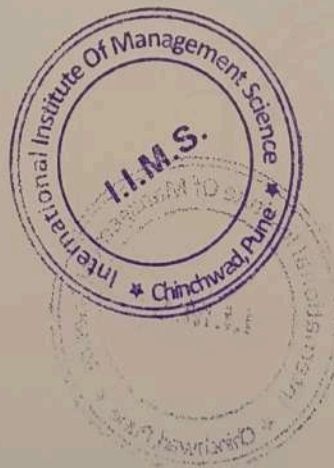

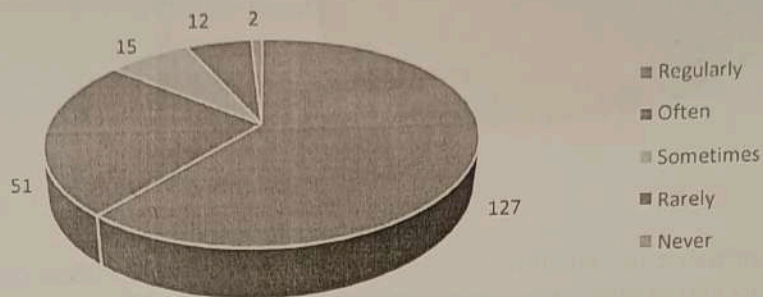

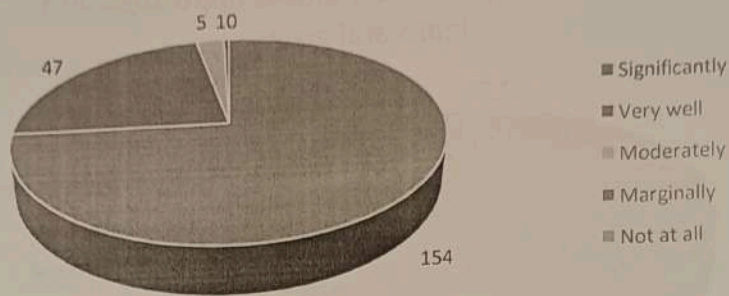

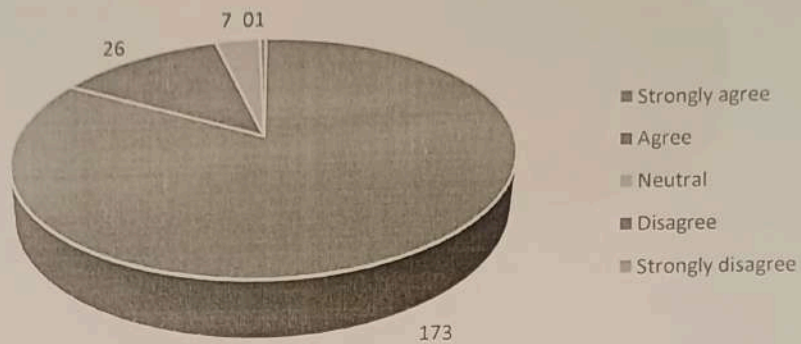

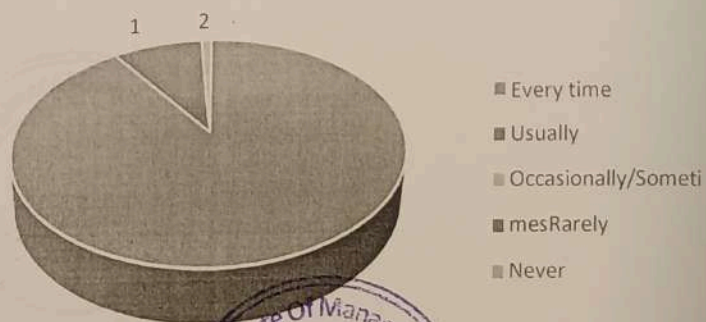



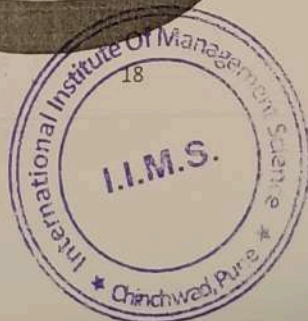

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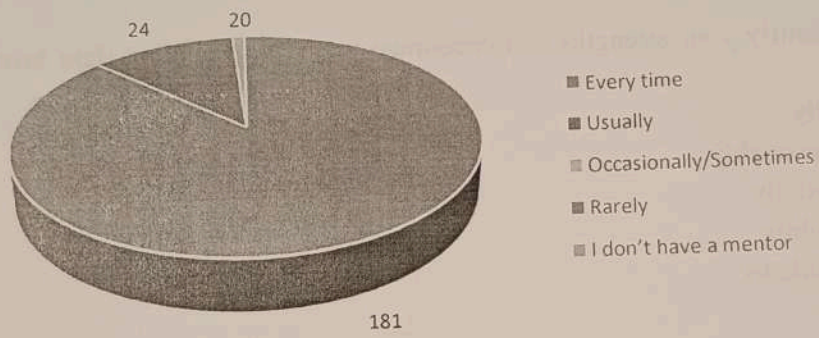

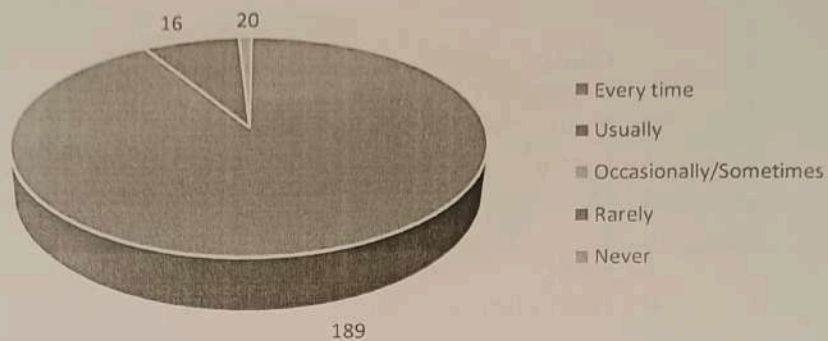

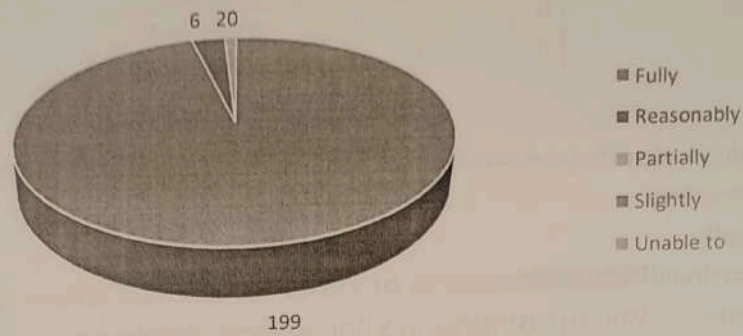

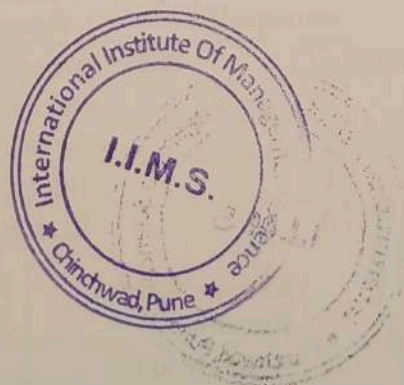

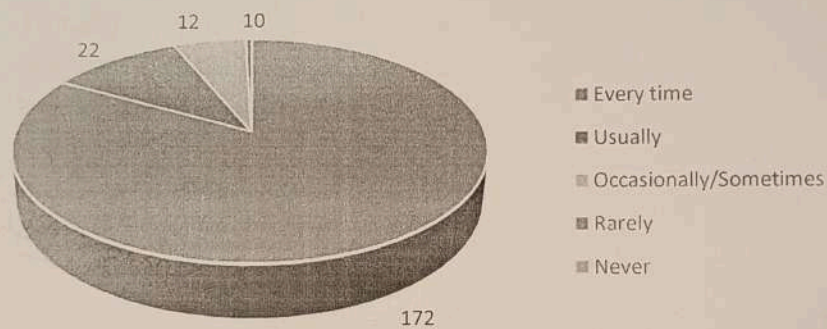

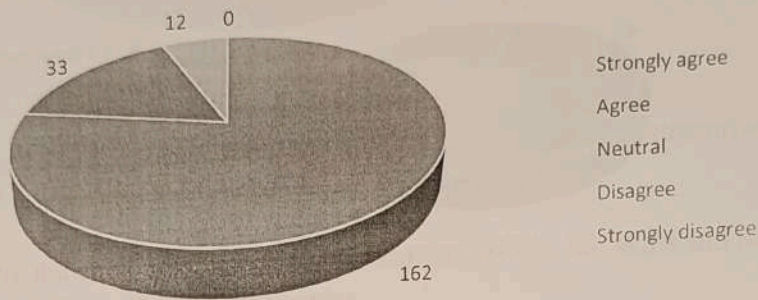

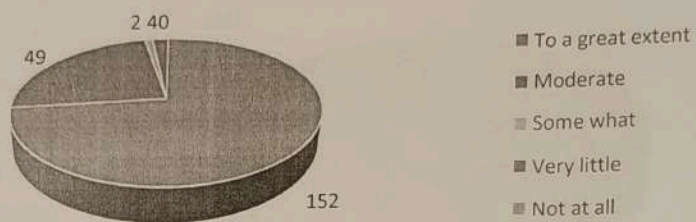



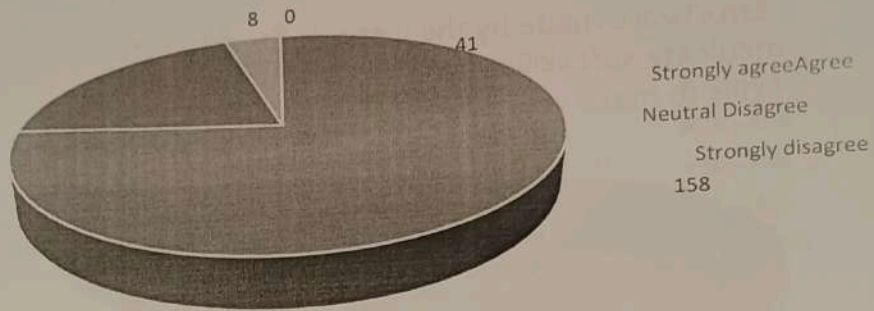

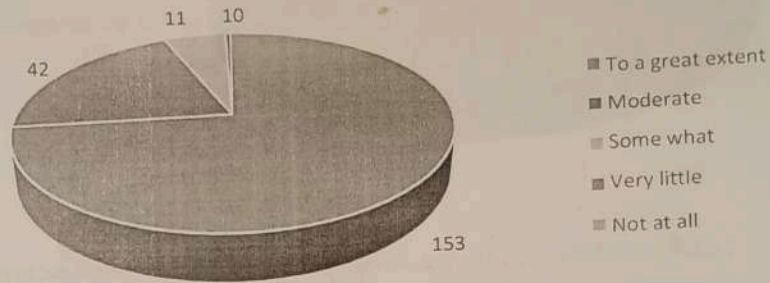



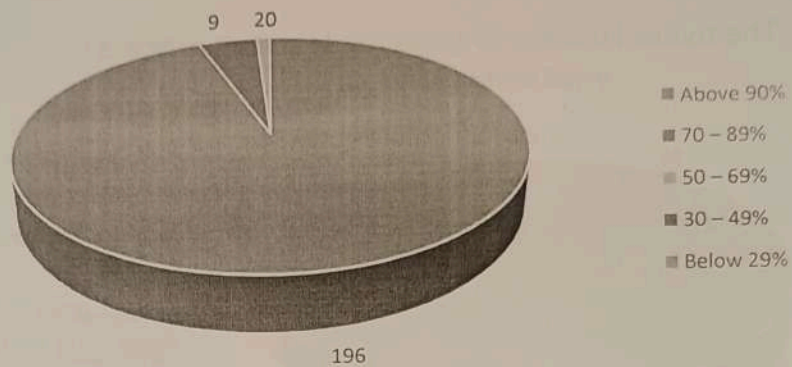

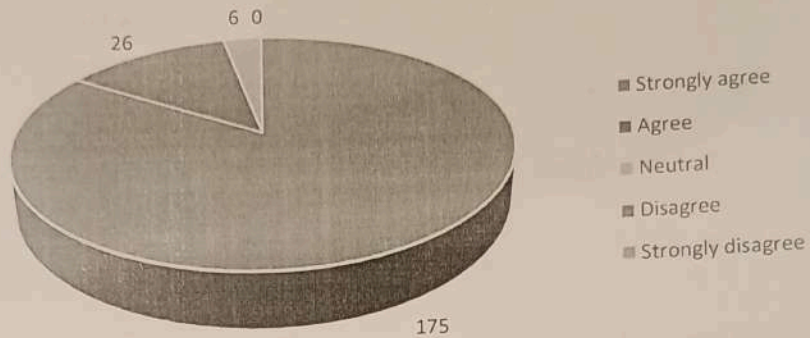




