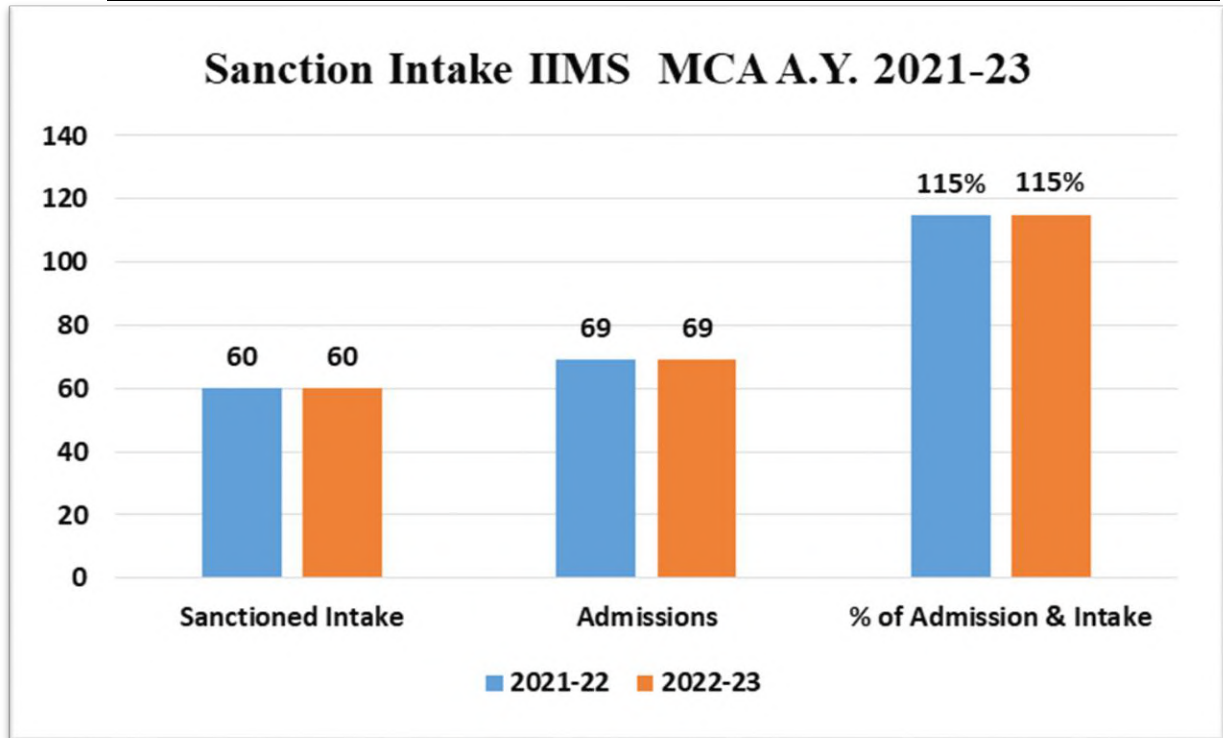

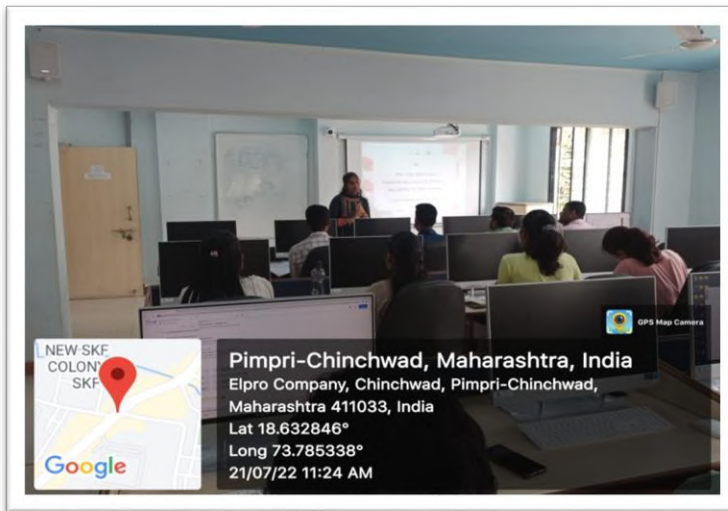


Communication Skills: She stressed the significance of communication skills in interviews and the workplace. She shared techniques for improving communication, both written and

Participants were encouraged to ask questions, seek clarification, and share their experiences.

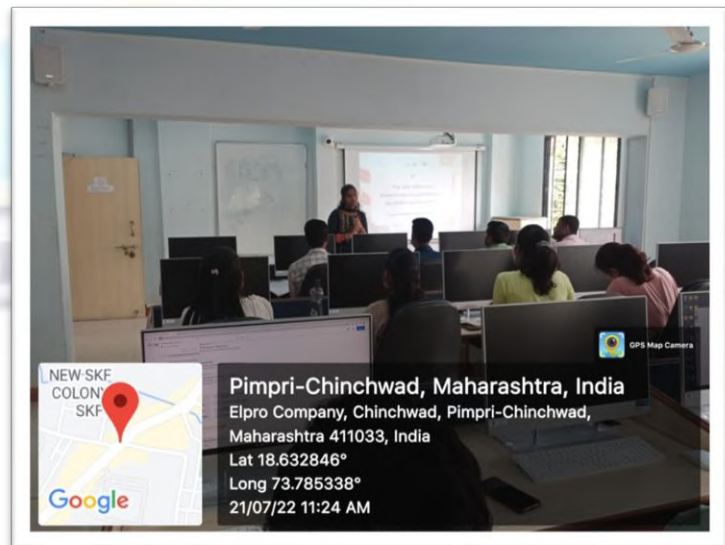

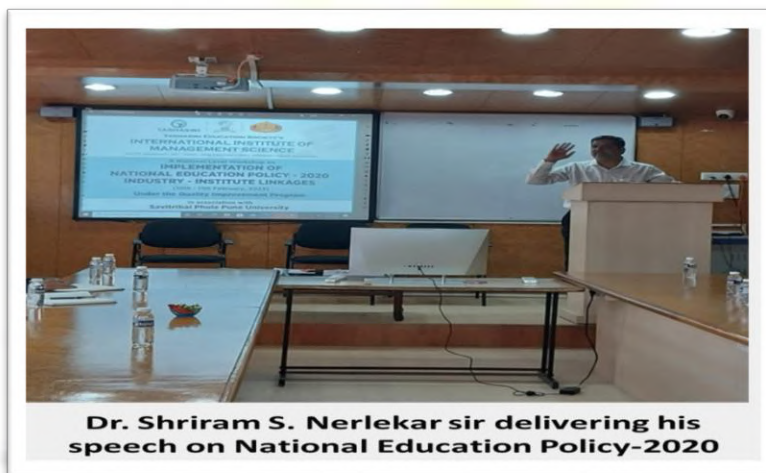
## Report on National Education Policy-2020

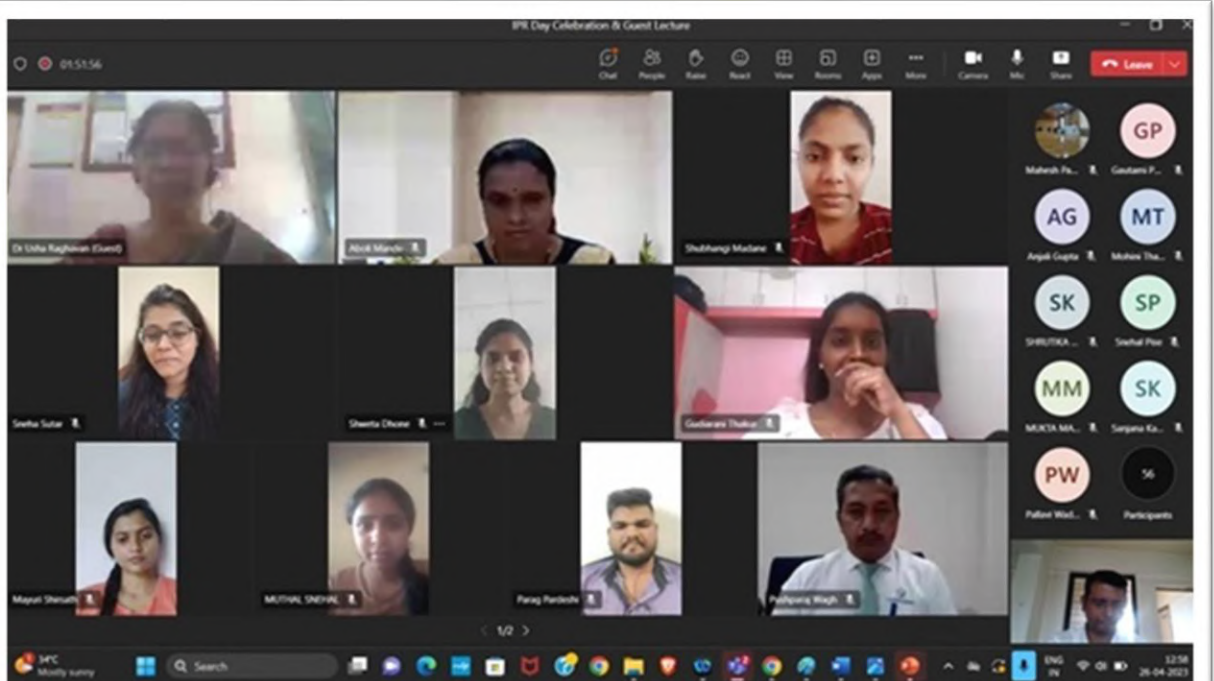

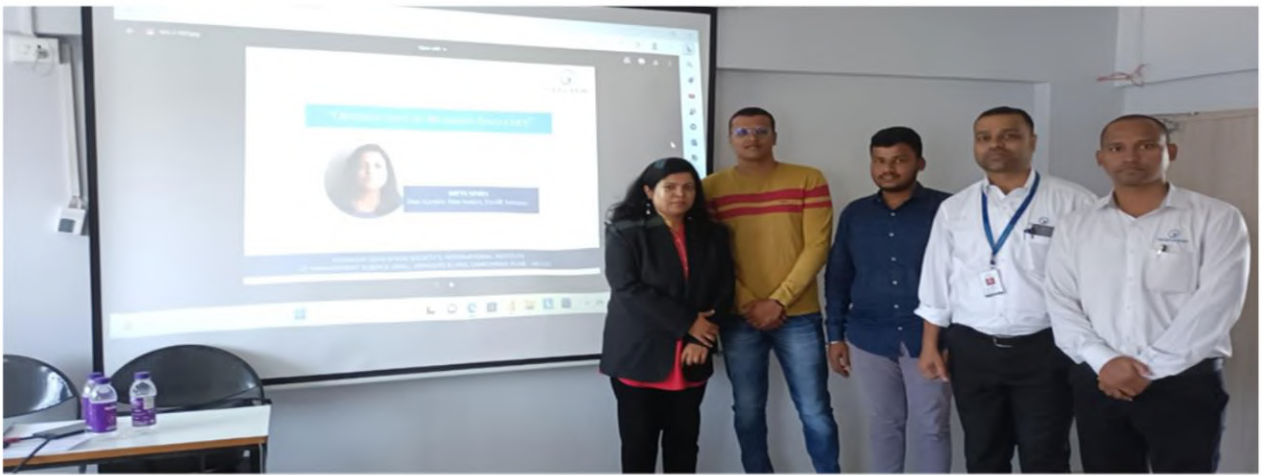

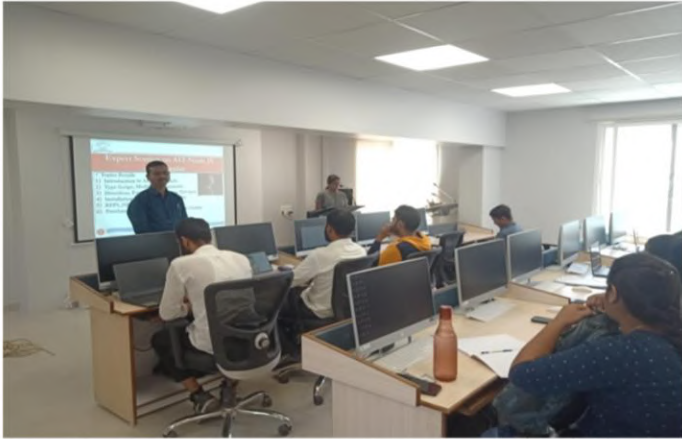
The workshop was spread over 6 hours. It was well designed syllabus focusing on the

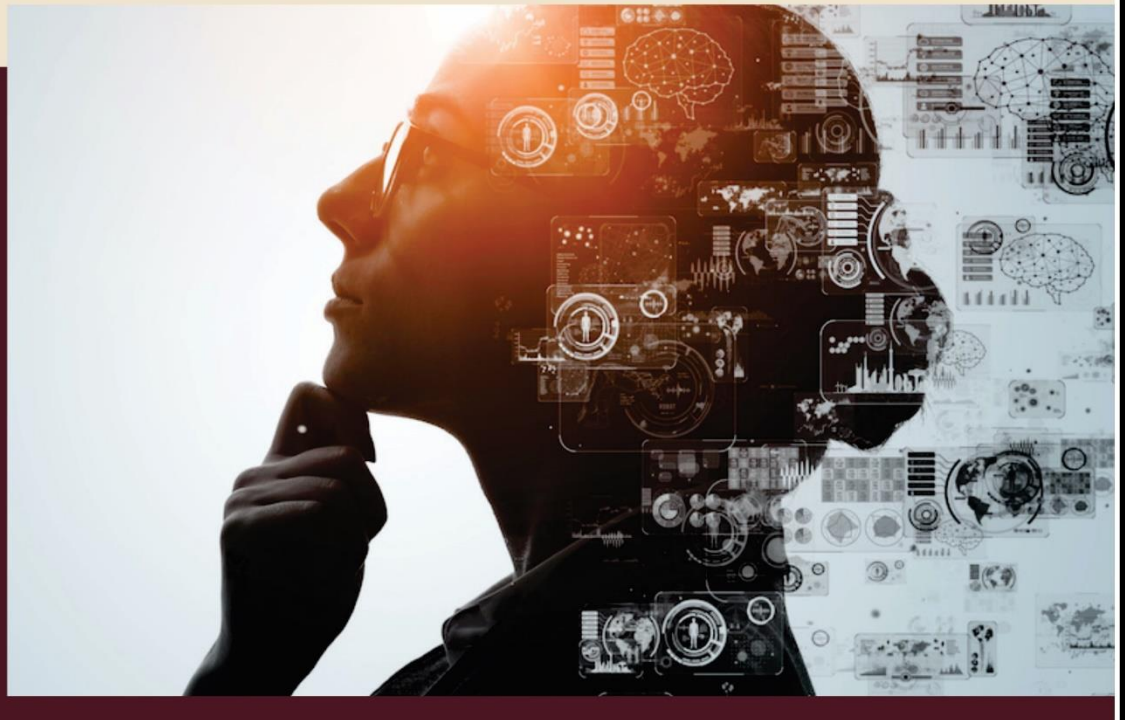

### Basic Objectives

### A. INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

(Gender Sensitization, Prevention and Prohibition of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students and Redressal of Grievances in Technical Institutions).

As required by AICTE, International Institute of Management Science has constituted the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) headed by the Director of the Institute. 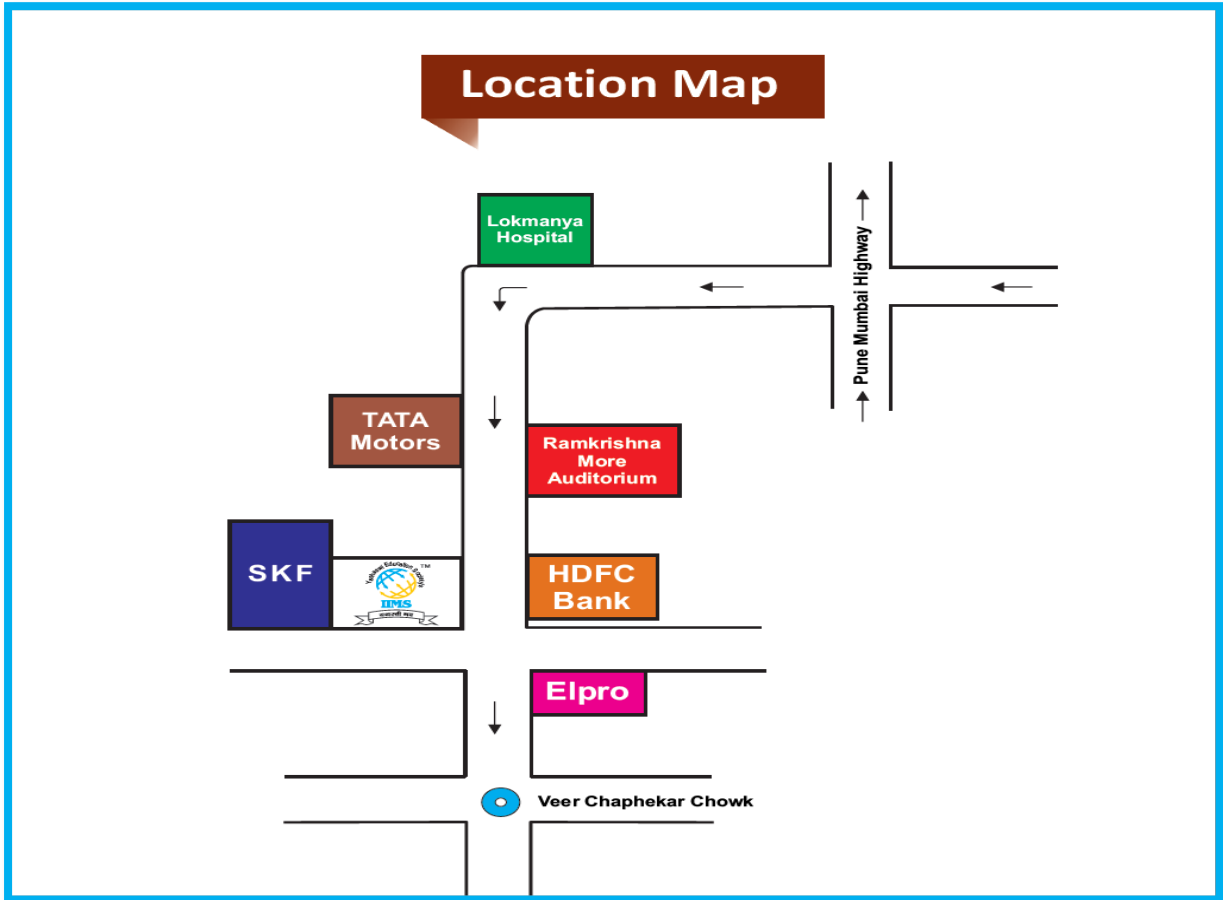
