#### Policy Applicability

This policy applies to all students of Yashaswi Education Society's International Institute of Management Science (IIMS) across all academic programs.

#### **Policy Details**

#### 1.Identification of Slow and Advanced Learners:

Slow and advanced learners will be identified based on academic performance (entrance exams, class participation, and exam results) and classroom observations. Additionally, students' level of comprehension and their ability to grasp concepts will also be considered.

#### 2. Support for Slow Learners:

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2.1 Remedial Classes: Remedial classes will be offered to slow learners, where they can receive personalized attention from faculty and work on strengthening their understanding of basic

2.2 Counselling and Mentoring: Slow learners will be encouraged to attend counselling sessions and receive guidance from academic mentors to help them address their learning challenges and

build confidence.

2.3 Additional Support: Extra classes, revision sessions, and will be provided to slow learners to give them more time to catch up with the curriculum.

3 Support for Advanced Learners:

3.1 Enrichment Programs: Advanced learners will be encouraged to participate in enrichment programs such as MOOCS, Swayam/NPTEL Courses, workshops, seminars, and online certification courses to enhance their knowledge and skills.

3.2 Research Opportunities: Advanced learners will be encouraged to engage in research

activities, publish papers.

3.3 Advanced learners will be motivated to contribute to the institution's academic reputation by participating in events like Avishkar, Hackathons, and other innovation platforms.

4. Monitoring and Mentorship:

Teachers will regularly monitor the progress of both slow and advanced learners, offering feedback and adapting teaching strategies to meet their needs.

5. Resources for Learning:

5.1 Library and Digital Resources: The library will ensure that it is stocked with resources that cater to both slow and advanced learners, including textbooks, reference materials, and online databases.

5.2 Online Learning: Opportunities to register for certification programs through platforms like NPTEL, IIT Bombay, and other relevant online education sources will be actively promoted. The institute will promote the use of online platforms for additional learning materials and MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) for both slow and advanced learners.

6. Specialized Classes and Workshops:

6.1 Workshops for Slow &Advanced Learners: Specialized workshops focusing on higherorder thinking, problem-solving, and innovation will be conducted for both to further their academic capabilities.

6.2 Revision Classes for Slow Learners: Additional revision classes and sessions will be conducted to support slow learners in catching up with their coursework and addressing gaps in

understanding.
